The Fairwind Training helmet has been designed and approved for training of military forces.

This helmet is composed by:

- One shell
- One chinstrap with fabric guard
- One fixed goggle clip
- One interchangeable liner easy to be removed and washed
- Two internal pockets for audibles



S: 52-54 cm

M: 54-56 cm

L: 57-59 cm

XL: 60-62 cm

USAGE

For best comfort the helmet must be adjusted according to the size of the user. The adjustable chinstrap has a buckle permitting a fast release/opening. To adjust the fit, remove the fabric guard, wear the helmet, close the buckle and adjust the chinstrap by making it tighter or loser.


Once set to the correct size, remove the helmet from the head, put back in place the fabric guard in the correct way – be careful not to cover the buckle.



POCKETS FOR AUDIBLES

To insert the audible inside the pocket, the padded protections at the ears must be removed.

ATTENTION: the two triangles inserts for audibles are not supplied with the spare kit so, they must not be removed from the helmet.

GOGGLE CLIP

To avoid the loss of the goggles during the jump, the helmet is supplied with a clip on the back. Open the clip button, insert the goggle strap around the helmet and close the clip.



MAINTENANCE

The shell of the helmet can be cleaned with a soft cloth lightly moistened with warm water. Do not use any solvent or chemical product to avoid damages to the shell.

The liner of the helmet is interchangeable and washable with cold water – be careful to not exceed a temperature of 30°C.

In case of a damaged liner, the spare liner can be easily replaced by the user.

The two inserts for audibles must not be removed from the helmet when the liner is replaced.
